20 May:

Wines that have scored full marks with Robert Parker or Wine Spectator magazine Restaurant Mosaic's cellar carries 11 wines which received 100 points (full marks) from either American wine critic Robert Parker or Wine Spectator magazine. It includes 10 Bordeaux wines from sweet to elderly vintages and one Rhône wine. These 11 acclaimed wines are three wines from Saint Emilion – Château Beausejour Duffau-Lagarrosse 2010, Château Troplong Mondot 2005 and Château Angelus 2005; two from Pessac-Léognan Château Pape Clément 2010 and Château La Mission Haut-Brion 2000; Château L'Evangile from Pomerol; Château Montrose from Saint Estéphe; Château Mouton Rothschild 1982 from Pauillac; Chateau Léoville Las Cases 2000 from Saint Julian; Chateau d'Yquem 2009 from Sauternes and Roger Sabon Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Secret des Sabon 2007 from Châteauneuf-du-Pape near Rhône wine.

#### 9 September: Kanonkop

Featuring wines from one of the country's most acclaimed estates and also attended by the current Kanonkop winemaker as well as two of his predecessors. All have won the International Winemaker of the Year accolade in different years. There's Jan "Boland" Coetzee who started his winemaking career at Kanonkop in 1967 and first planted the vines at Kanonkop; Beyers Truter, the founder and chairman of the SA Pinotage Association, who in 1991 was named International Winemaker of the Year for his Kanonkop Pinotage 1989 and current winemaker Abrie Beeslaar, who was awarded International Winemaker of the Year in 2015. The wines that won the cellar masters' the award will also be tasted. The tasting at Mosaic will be a vertical tasting of Paul Sauer (third Bordeaux blend label in South Africa) including 2015 from the tank, 2012, 2010, 2009 from the Guild Auction, 2003, 1996 and 1990.

#### 22 September: Paul Cluver

The evening will see the launch of Restaurant Mosaic's own 2015 pinot noir, made under its own label, by Paul Cluver winemaker Andries Burger. The pinot noir and chardonnay's to be tasted include the 2008 and 2013 Pinot Noir; Seven Flags Pinot Noir 2010; Seven Flags Pinot Noir 2013; Chardonnay 2011 and Seven Flags Chardonnay 2014.

#### 28 October: Hartenberg

Set in the Bottellary Hills bordering Stellenbosch, Hartenberg is a family estate renowned internationally for its award-winning wines as well as their Shiraz. Wines in the line-up include Riesling 2010 and 2013; Riesling Tenacity Riesling 2013; Shiraz 2011; Shiraz 2009; The Mackenzie 2004; the Pontac 2000, the last pontac produced in South Africa and the Weisser Riesling Noble Late Harvest 2010.

**18 November:** New champagnes and bubbly acquired this year by Restaurant Mosaic
