

ANOTHER ACCOLADE FOR MOSAIC



Restaurant Mosaic at The Orient Boutique Hotel in Elandsfontein celebrates its 10th anniversary this year. To put the cherry on top of a golden year for the restaurant, it has just been awarded another spot in the Mercedes-Benz Eat Out Restaurant Awards' Top 10, the only restaurant outside of the Western Cape to make the cut. Mosaic has been a top 10 contender in these awards for the last eight years, together with

executive chef Chantel Dartnell, who scooped the Chef of the Year title twice - in 2009 and 2014. This fifth place in the Eat Out Awards is one of the last in a series of accolades for Mosaic this year. Mosaic also

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walked away with platinum status for the 10th consecutive year in The American Express Fine Dining Awards, the Best Chef - 500 Top Chefs in

the world, where Chantel ranked 261st from only a handful of chefs from Africa, the Wine Spectator: Best of Award of Excellence (the only restaurant in Gauteng and one of only three South African establish-

ments recognised by this influential global awards programme) and the World of Fine Wine "World's Best Wine Lists Awards" - Best

Overall Wine List for Africa and the Middle East, Best Champagne and Sparkling Wine List, Best Dessert and Fortified Wine List, Best By-the-

Glass Wine List, and a special Jury Prize for the quality and excellence of Mosaic's approach to all things wine, to name but a few.

"My team is made up of people from the local community, none of whom have had any classical training or any other training for that matter, apart from what they've learnt in the Mosaic kitchen. That's our philosophy: building up our team and empowering them! Mosaic is an experience, a destination and celebration of life...and I aim to further enhance that for all our guests," says Chantel.
