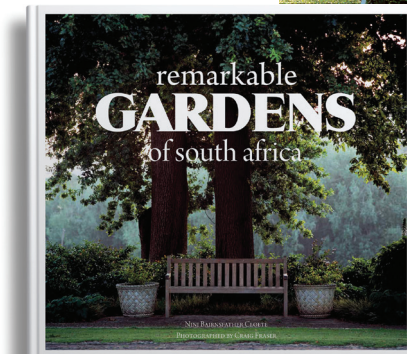

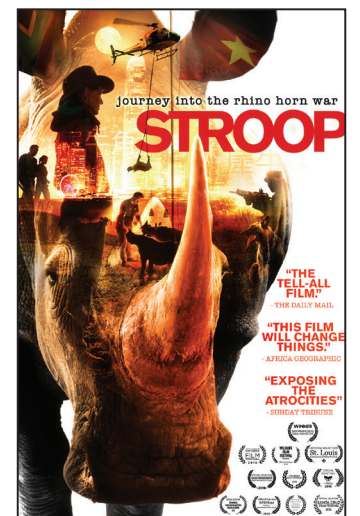
MOSAIC WINS AGAIN
